America250 Guilford County Set to Dedicate Community Time Capsule

Ceremony set for April 18 at the High Point Museum

Guilford County, NC – America250 Guilford County invites the community to be part of history this weekend. The local organizing committee for America250 events will host a time capsule dedication ceremony on Saturday, April 18, from 2 to 4:00 p.m. at the High Point Museum, 1859 E. Lexington Avenue.

“This is our organization’s signature event and will include artifacts representing communities across Guilford County,” says committee chair Sarah Lanse. “Both Greensboro and High Point have incredible Fourth of July celebrations, and this time capsule is our way of contributing something lasting and meaningful that will connect today’s Guilford County to the next 50 years.”

The family-friendly event will include speakers, activities for all ages, reenactors, fife-and-drum performers, artifact displays, a photo booth, and, of course, cake. The organization hopes to welcome 250 guests of all ages to celebrate more than 250 years of history.

Community members still have time to contribute to the time capsule. Anyone with Guilford County-related artifacts is encouraged to submit them for consideration on the organization’s website at america250guilford.com/time-capsule-donations/.

America250 Guilford County will collect artifacts through the end of 2026. Artifacts will be held in the High Point Historical Society Collections at the High Point Museum and will remain sealed until July 4, 2076.

Saturday’s event is free and open to all ages. “Our hope is that families will attend together and return on July 4, 2076, when the capsule is opened,” Lanse said. “Maybe they’ll rediscover a drawing or photo they contributed. We envision this as a full-circle moment connecting generations across five decades.”
